PRESS NOTE

It is brought to the notice of all political parties, candidates, their workers, supporters and sympathizers that sticking posters, writing slogans, painting election symbols, etc. for the contesting candidates on any kind of properties like Govt. building, public premises, private properties (with or without permission), hut structures, wall, tree, fence, post, pole or any other erection causes defacement of the properties and is not permissible. It is a cognizable offence under section 4 of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Prevention of defacement of Property Regulation, 1987.

All political parties and candidates who have defaced the buildings/properties by sticking posters, writing slogans, painting of election symbols, etc. hereby required to remove such posters slogans, paintings, etc. from the walls of buildings/properties immediately failing which action would be taken against them under the provisions of section 3 of the A & N Islands, Prevention of defacement of Property Regulation, 1987.

The political parties, candidates and their workers, supporters and sympathizers are hereby further cautioned not to do any kind of defacement, as mentioned above.
